Sir Erik Martel (Joe Goodwin): In over twenty years in the SCA I have had the honor to serve the Barony of Iron Mountain as its Sheriff, and as Knights Marshal, for two separate tenures. I have also had the opportunity to plan and prepare well over a dozen feasts during those same time periods. I even had the good fortune to be given the chance to Fairecrat Magna Faire. At the Kingdom level, I have served as the Deputy Authorization Marshall for armored combat, combat archery and siege engines for two years; the Deputy Kingdom Seneschal for waivers for the past five years; and most recently as the Deputy Earl Marshall for Armored Combat.

It has been my distinct honor to have been inducted into the Order of Scarlet Star, The Legion of the Bear, The Order of the Bough, The Order of the Sable Sword and the Order of the Chivalry. I was also honored to be chosen as general for several battles, notably Gatalop and Castle Wars.

Mistress Gwenndolynn ni hAilleachain, OP (nuh halle-yah-han) (Stacy Hall): I had the good fortune to find the SCA in 1988 in An Dun Theine, and finally join in membership in Shire Eagle, in 1990. While in Shire Eagle, I had the honor to serve as a dance mistress, and then Seneschal for two years prior to graduating and moving to Iron Mountain in 1994. Since then, I had the pleasure of serving the Barony as Exchequer, and autocratting several events, including the Investiture of Kojin and Marsali. I was honored to serve Meridies first as the Deputy Seneschal for Incipient Groups, and later, as Kingdom Seneschal where, among other adventures, I was pleased to usher Glenn Abhainn from Principality to Kingdom-hood. Most recently, I have the pleasure to become a Deputy Seneschal Ombudsman for the North Alabama district.

I have had the honor of being awarded the Sanguine Mountain and Oriad and am a member of the Order of the Pelican since 2003.

The Society has afforded both of us several opportunities and challenges, and we look forward to more of each in the future.

Katrina loves to dance; she founded Iron Mountain's Dance Guild, which was used as a model when Saltare, the Kingdom Dance Guild, was formed. She loves cooking, and is a Companion of the Scarlet Star. She also loves the bardic arts, and has served as Kingdom Bard. Katrina has twice served as Queen of Meridies. She is proud of signing the charter to establish the Coursing Guild during her first reign, and instituting Rapier fighting in Meridies during her second reign.

Katrina is also an enthusiastic admirer of armored combat and sponsors an annual fundraiser tournament benefiting the Wounded Warrior Project.
