Magna Faire is Iron Mountain's premier arts and sciences faire in which the competitors have the unique responsibility of judging each other. Magna Faire's category listing may be found HERE.

In conjunction with Magna Faire there is also a Kingdom Arts and Sciences Regional Faire where entries are judged with the same guidelines and caliber of judges as those of Kingdom Arts and Sciences. Competitors may choose to place one or all of their entries in one faire or both. The two faires run congruently so there is only one set up and display required. Regional Faire judges judge while Magna Faire is taking place.
